The public is invited to the 14th Annual Memorial Day program at the Wilton Post Office, on Monday, May 25, at 10:00 a.m. The program will include raising of the American and POW flags by local Boy Scout Troop #581. The Wilton Christian High School Choir will perform a medley of patriotic songs. Pastor Norman Greenfield, of the Wilton Bible Church, as well as local Veterans, will share a special message for this Memorial Day.

The commemorative brick pathway through the rose garden continues to grow, with new bricks recently being added. To date nearly 400 bricks have been placed. Purchase price of a brick is \$25.00. They have been purchased to commemorate birthdays, anniversaries, a loved one, and many other remembrances. Bricks will be sold on Memorial Day.

Following the program you are invited to visit a memorial display by the Wilton History Group, enjoy a stroll through the Rose Garden, where a small American Flag will be placed at each rose planted in memory of loved ones who served our country. The Wilton Fire Department's Auxiliary will be selling hot dogs and refreshments.
