Associate Membership Application

Introduction

The Alta Mesa Gun Club was incorporated in 1948 as a non-profit organization and has a long and distinguished history. The Club was principally formed to enable its members to become and remain proficient in the use of firearms and engage in social and educational activities. You must be eighteen years of age or older to become a member. Your membership entitles you to participate in the Club's activities. Additionally, although not members, your spouse and minor children may participate in the Club's activities and enjoy the benefits of your membership. Each member is required to pay annual dues.

As a non-profit corporation, we must rely upon the membership to maintain the facility and keep it running properly. Work days are held as needed to facilitate the required upkeep. Your participation in the work days is encouraged.

There are Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws that provide a framework for the Club's structure and operation. These documents provide for two classes of Club membership: Active and Associate. The Active membership is limited to a maximum of Twenty Five (25) members, all other members are Associate members. A Board of Directors and various Officers are elected from the Active membership ranks. Associate members may be asked to become an active member when a vacancy occurs.

The Club's corporate powers are exercised by or under the authority of the Board of Directors. The Board may authorize its Officers, elected from the Active membership, to assist in the conduct of the Club's day to day business and affairs.

Your application will be reviewed by the membership committee and voted upon by the Active membership. Your admission as an Associate member in this corporation must be approved by two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors or by a two-thirds vote of the Active members.

While not required, membership in the National Rifle Association is encouraged.

All shooting activities are governed by posted Range Safety Rules. Each shoot participant is responsible for compliance with these rules. You will be provided with a separate copy of these rules for your review. After you have read these rules, had an opportunity to ask the Range Officer any and all questions you may have concerning obligations, limitations, and requirements contained therein, you will be asked to certify your understanding and agreement to comply with said rules. Thereafter your signed copy will be attached to this application and incorporated herein by reference.

A brief outline of some of the Club's activities follows:

Trap shooting is allowed on Monday, Thursday, and Friday evenings from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.; certain Saturdays and Sundays and specified Holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Certain restrictions apply. A complete schedule of shoot days is posted in the clubhouse.

Regular business meetings are conducted on the first Thursday of each month at 8:00 p.m.

Regular Public Shoots are held on the fourth Sunday of each month, starting at 9:00 a.m.

Dinners, Barbecues, and other activities are usually conducted several times each year.
